Inside=Outside

In this week's *parsha* it says, "... and you shall make its lamps seven; he shall kindle its lamps and it will cast light in the direction of its face." (Shemos 25:37)

As Purim approaches, we think about Queen Esther and the fact that she actually had to marry King Achashveirosh. How sorry we are



for a woman who has to marry a man against her will. But aside from our emotional feeling, there is a halachic question that is discussed in the poskim as to how she was permitted to marry a gentile.

Going back to the *Menorah*, it seems obvious that if one were to light the candles, they would cast light. The Pele Yoetz explains as follows: There are times when a person will perform a mitzvah perfectly, however because he has an ulterior motive for doing the mitzvah, it is called a mitzvah "shelo lishma" and the mitzvah does not have the power to accomplish that which it was supposed to. On the other hand, sometimes a person is forced to commit a sin against his will. As he commits the sin, he feels remorse and pain for being forced to do something which he does not want to do.


It is well known that the Vilna Gaon had once walked into a synagogue and said "There is no room inside this shul for me. It is too stuffy inside." The people asked him, "What do you mean? It does not seem stuffy to us at all!" He replied, "all the prayers that were prayed in this shul never ascended to Heaven because of the improper thoughts and behaviors in the shul." Here again, lack of certain side issues can prevent a mitzvah from accomplishing what it is supposed to accomplish.

There was a similar problem after the *mishkan* was built: Moshe Rabbeinu offered a special prayer that the Divine Presence should reside on the handiwork of klal Yisrael. Here we see again that just because the *mishkan* was built correctly according to the physical

Mishneh Berurah Q&A

Questions and answers culled from the Keter Hatorah Semicha Program in Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim with the Mishneh Berurah. For details on this program see www.RBSsemicha.com. Questions written by Lev Seltzer and used with permission.

This was the first Purim thirteen-year-old Hudy would be celebrating as an "adult" and, while he was excited about his costume and the Purim Seuda, he was not so interested in his obligation for *matanas l'evyonim*, and wanted to give the minimal amount. According to the M.B., what is the minimum he must give to fulfill the *mitzvah* of *matanas l'evyonim*?

- 1) Two *prutas* (a "*pruta*" is the smallest coin with which one can buy something).
- 2) Three *k'beitzim* (slices) of bread (or sufficient money to purchase this).
- 3) A regular meal (e.g. a Felafel, or sufficient money to purchase this).
- 4) An important meal (e.g. a steak, etc., or sufficient money to purchase this).

1. Two *prutas*, as the definition of a gift is just one *pruta*. However, since in our times, it is impossible to purchase any food item with just a *pruta*, many *poskim* now hold that the minimum amount is higher than a *pruta*, and should be an amount that one can buy a food item with. Some *poskim* hold that since the purpose of this *mitzvah* is to give the poor person a meal, one should calculate the cost of a meal, and that becomes the minimum amount. The amounts given among the *poskim* range from 10 to 50 shekels per poor person.

Yes. Since Shlomo Kagan has **received** the gift on Purim day, Richard Kagan has fulfilled his obligation. The fact that he used a messenger, or that he paid for it a week beforehand, does not detract from the proper fulfillment.

plan, it does not mean it was built with all the proper thoughts and side issues, and therefore there is no assurance that the Divine Presence would automatically rest on it.

Purim is a time that we stress building our relationships with our fellow man. We have *matanas l'evyonim* and *mishloach manos*. However, creating a gift package fit for the centerfold of *Mishpacha* Magazine and giving it to someone who is expected to "oooh" and aaah" over your amazing handiwork is not sufficient. Instead, we are supposed to be thinking of others and using the package to show our care.

Similarly, there are those people who think that there can be no easier mitzvah than to get drunk at the Purim Seuda (and even easier to get drunk before it!). However, it seems to me that it would be easier to fast on Yom Kippur than to drink *properly* on Purim.

"...and (the lamp) will cast light in the direction of its face..." tells us that the *menorah's* lights (which are representative of mitzvos, as in "ki ner mitzvah...") are supposed to brighten the face (referring to the desired accomplishment of the *mitzvah*).

As we plan our Purim celebrations for a holiday of simcha and fun, it should be in a way that it is not for our personal gratification; rather it should be for showing our true face: A desire to bring glory to Hashem.

This is **Yehuda Menachem Lieberman**.

Just as he'll take a siddur off the shelf each time he comes to daven, he'll also put it back when he finishes.

פנימיות = חיצוניות

"וָעָשִׂיתָ אֵת גַרֹתֵיהָ שִׁבְעָה וְהֵעֵלָה אֵת גַרֹתֵיהָ וְהַאִיר עַל עָבֵר פניה" (שמות כה:לז)

כשפורים מתקרב, אנו חושבים על סיפורה של אסתר המלכה, שהיא נאלצה להינשא למלך אחשוורוש. כמה אנו מצטערים על אישה שצריכה להינשא לגבר בעל כורחה. אך מלבד התחושה הרגשית שלנו, יש שאלה הלכתית שנדונה בפוסקים כיצד הורשה לה להינשא

נחזור לסוגיית המנורה - נראה ברור שאם מדליקים את הנרות, הם יטילו אור. הפלא יועץ מסביר כדלקמן: יש מיקרים שאדם יקיים מצווה בצורה מושלמת, אולם מכיוון שיש לו מניע נוסף לעשות את המצווה, זה נקרא מצווה "שלא לשמה" והמצווה חסרה את הכוח לפעול את מה שהיתה אמורה. לעומת זאת, לעיתים אדם נאלץ לחטוא נגד רצונו. כשהוא חוטא הוא מתחרט וחש כאב על כך שהוא נאלץ לעשות את מעשה החטא שהוא לא רוצה לעשות.

יש סיפור ידוע בו הגאון מווילנא נכנס לבית כנסת ואמר, "אין מקום בתוך בית הכנסת הזה בשבילי. זה צפוף מדי בפנים." האנשים שאלו אותו, "למה אתה מתכוון? בכלל לא נראה צפוף!" הוא ענה, "כל התפילות שהתפללו בבית הכנסת הזה מעולם לא עלו לשמים בגלל המחשבות וההתנהגויות הבלתי ראויות בבית הכנסת." גם כאן, דברים שנראים צדדיים יכולים למנוע מצווה מלהגיע למה שהיא אמורה להשיג.

הייתה בעיה דומה לאחר בניית המשכן: משה רבנו התפלל תפילה מיוחדת שהשכינה תשכון על מעשה ידי כלל ישראל. כאן אנו רואים שוב, שלמרות שהמשכן נבנה נכון על פי כל התוכניות ההנדסיות, אין זה אומר בהכרח שהוא נבנה עם כל המחשבות והכוונות הנכונות, ולכן אין הבטחה שה' ישכין שכינתו עליו.

פורים הוא זמן בו אנו מדגישים את בניית מערכות היחסים שבין אדם לחבירו. נותנים מתנות לעניים ומשלוח מנות. זה לא מספיק רק לתת את המנות והמתנות באופן שהעיקר הוא להראות את עבודת היד והיצירתיות שלנו, אלא זה אמור להיות בגלל שאנחנו חושבים על אחרים. יש אנשים שחושבים שאין מצווה קלה יותר מאשר להשתכר. נראה לי קל יותר לצום ביום כיפור מאשר להשתכר כמו שצריכים בפורים.

הפסוק שציטטנו, "וָהָעֻלָּה אָת נֵרֹתֵיהַ וְהָאִיר עַל עָבֶר פְּנֵיהַ", מגיד לנו שנרות המנורה, המייצגים מצוות שאנחנו עושים ו"נר מצווה"), אמורים להבהיר את המראה והמשמעות של המצוות האלו שאנחנו אמורים לקיים. כשאנחנו מתכננים את חגיגות הפורים שלנו כדי שיהיה חג של שמחה וכיף, זה צריך להיות באופן שלא רק עבור קורת הרוח האישית שלנו, אלא להראות את האמת שלה, שזה להביא כבוד ותפארת להקב"ה.
