

## Hope For A New Year

When Rosh Hashanah is ushered in, we are excited about the greeting of our *Melech*, the King of Kings. It is an opportunity for us to be close to royalty. Yet when we think of Hashem's ability to see us inside and out, we become frightened as we realize that He will see our shortcomings and faults and thereby, maybe, not accept our *tefillos*. As we sway and pray, to the onlookers it may look as if we are doing well, but He sees those lapses in our concentration and inadequacies.



How can we be successful when *Hakadosh Baruch Hu* knows the truth?

On *Rosh Hashanah* during the *Chazaras Hashatz* we say the following *piyut*:

**ליודע מחשבות ביום דין - לכובש כעסו בדין**

The *Koshenitzer Maggid* explains it as follows: *Hakadosh Baruch Hu* is *yoda'a machshavos* (knows thoughts) meaning he knows our innermost thoughts. However, He is also *koveish ca'aso* (suppresses His anger), meaning that he understands the frailty of human nature and suppresses His anger, opting to judge us based on our external pose. **This definitely gives us hope.** If we do the minimum of at least going through the motions of davening properly, we should merit to not only that He will be *koveish ca'aso badin*, but we should also merit to **לרחם עמו ביום דין**—that Hashem should have mercy on His people on the Day of Judgment.

We would like to remind everyone that we will have a TWO additional shofar blowings each day of Rosh Hashanah. Women with small children are asked to leave their children\*\* home under the care of the fathers and come to hear the shofar at either 12:50 or 17:45.

*Kesiva v'Chasima Tova!*

*\*\*A "small child" is any child who cannot stand by themselves. A child in a stroller or held by the mother must remain outside the room.*

The Gabbaim are pleased to offer many kibbudim of Rosh Hashanah to the kehilla. 100% of your winning bid will go towards Beis Midrash Ahavas Shalom, and is deductible from Maaser. Since it is considered meritorious to be called to the Torah on Rosh Hashanah, one should extend himself to purchase an Aliyah. We have provided the chart below to help you select your bids, and to hopefully speed up the bidding process.

NOTE: In order to speed bidding and not inconvenience the Kehilla, new bids must be at least 50₪ more than the previous bid. Once bids reach 500₪, new bids must be 100₪ more than the previous bid.
