Megilla For Women

- Megilla at night after the 18:15 Maariv (Ezras Nashim and Hall) and 20:15 (Beis Medrash)
- Megilla in the morning with Shacharis at **06:00** (Hall) and **07:30** (Ezras Nashim), and **10:15** (Beis Medrash).
- There will not be an Ezras Nashim for the 08:30 Shacharis—please choose a minyon before or after.

Excessive noise for the **Hamans** during קריאת is not allowed. Examples of what is considered excessive noise:



- Explosives, of any sort
- Air horns any make, model, deafening/ wake the dead scale.


