# יום הכיפורים

## **Always A Winner**

Aseres yemei teshuva, which culminates on Yom Kippur, brings hope to some, and despair to others. The optimists say, "This year will be the year that I, with Hashem's help, will turn things around!" The pessimists say, "It hasn't happened until now, so why should I be able to turn things around this year? In fact, doing teshuva is so hard that I can't believe that Hashem expects me to do it!"



The yetzer hara has many ways to keep us from doing the right thing. One of the ploys he uses is by making us feel that we are out of the race. I heard from a great educator the following approach. A Rebbe took his class on a trip to a 50-story building in the city and said, "The first one to climb the staircase to the top floor will get a special ice cream as a prize." Most of the class runs to try to be the first one to the top, but there is one kid who doesn't even try. The Rebbe asked him, "Why are you just standing in the lobby?" and he responds, "Why should I try? I know that I am not the fastest runner in the class, so there is no way I can win. If I start climbing the staircase, I will surely be a loser!" The Rebbe thought about his student's answer, and then responded, "It is still worth the climb! Even if you don't make it to the 50th floor, you still might make it to the 20th floor, and the view from there is still amazing!"



So too there are many pursuits: Even if we don't complete them, just starting and taking them as far as we can is still worthwhile.

In a similar vein, the *baalei mussar* tell us that there are many levels of *teshuva*, and one should never be despondent and give up. This is because every level is a major accomplishment on its own, which brings a person to a completely different place.

However, there is also another approach that I saw in the

As per the Rav, the most important part of Yom Kippur is to fast—more important than davening in a minyon (and not fasting). Someone davening in an outdoor minyon who might become dehydrated and in need of water should instead consider davening not in a minyon and inside an air-conditioned space.

#### Q&A: A Tallis Brocho—or not?

Congregation Shaarei Shamayim finished musaf on Yom Kippur and let everyone out for a 2-hour break until mincha.

Reuven took off his tallis gadol, left his tallis katan on, and went home for a nap. According to the M.B., when Reuven returns to shul, is he required to make a new brocho on the tallis?

Yes. According to the M.B., he must make a new *brocho* on the *tallis godol*, even though he was still wearing his *tzitzis* (*tallis katan*). It should be noted that according to Rav Moshe Feinstein, he does not need to make a new *brocho* since he you kept his *tzitzis* on.

#### **Q&A: A Well-Rested Yahrzeit Candle**

On erev Yom Kippur, Moe Shapiro lit a Yahrzeit candle for his older brother Bernie, who died during the *neila* service of Yom Kippur of the previous year. At the end of Yom Kippur, the candle was still lit. May Moe use this Yahrzeit candle for *havdalah* of Yom Kippur and make the *brocho* of *borei morei ha'eish* on it?



No. Moe is not permitted to use this candle because the purpose of the Yahrzeit candle is to memorialize a loved one, and not for illumination. Even though this candle was lit before Yom Kippur and "rested" the entire day, it does not help in this situation. However, if Moe would take an identical Yahrzeit candle and light it for **illumination** on erev Shabbos or erev Yom Kippur, then he would be permitted to use that particular candle for *havdalah*.

name of the *Sefer Haikarim*. We say in Tehillim (130:4) א א בייעמָר הַסְלִיחָה לְמען תּוּרָא – For with You is forgiveness, so that You be feared. The difficulty with this is obvious: The fact that Hashem will forgive us should not bring us to fear Him, but rather to **love** Him! The *Sefer Haikarim* responds that without the possibility of *teshuva* in the wings, we would consider ourselves a lost cause and even our fear of Hashem would suffer. But now, in *aseres yimei* teshuva, Hashem is close to us because he wants to forgive us (as the verse says, "bi'hiyoso karov", "when he is close to us"). Since we know that Hashem is waiting to forgive us, this motivates us to do Teshuva, which will cause us to fear Hashem.

Hence, *Aseres Yimei Teshuva*, culminating with Yom Kippur, should be the most encouraging time of year. Hashem is here saying, "I am not giving up on you!" Let us do our part and stay in the game, so that we can reach greater levels of *yiras Hashem*.



#### תמיד מנצחים

עשרת ימי תשובה, המסתיים ביום כיפור, מביא תקווה לחלקנו, וייאוש לאחרים. האופטימיים אומרים, "השנה הזו תהיה השנה שבה אני, בע"ה, אצליח לשנות את המצב!" הפסימיסטים אומרים, "לא הצלחתי עד עכשיו, אז למה שאצליח לתקן דברים השנה! למעשה, לעשות תשובה זה כל כך קשה שאני לא יודע איך ה' מצפה ממני לעשות זאת!"

ליצר הרע יש דרכים רבות למנוע מאיתנו לעשות את הדבר הנכון. אחת התכסיסים היא לגרום לנו להרגיש שאין לנו סיכוי. שמעתי ממחנך מוסמך את הגישה הבאה. הרבי לקח את כיתתו לטיול בבניין בן 50 קומות בעיר ואמר, "הראשון לטפס במדרגות לקומה העליונה יקבל פרס של גלידה מיוחדת". רוב הכיתה מהרו לנסות להיות הראשון, אבל ילד אחד לא זז. הרבי שאל אותו: "למה אתה סתם עומד בלובי?" והוא עונה, "למה לי לנסות? אני יודע שאני לא הכי מהיר בכיתה, אז אין סיכוי שאוכל לנצח. אם אתחיל לטפס במדרגות, בטוח שאהיה לוזר!" הרבי חשב על תשובתו של תלמידו, ואז השיב, "עדיין שווה את המאמץ! גם אם לא תגיע לקומה ה-50, אתה עדיין עלול להגיע לקומה ה-20, והנוף משם גם מדהים!"

כך גם יש הרבה עיסוקים: גם אם אנחנו לא משלימים אותם, פשוט להתחיל ולקחת אותם הכי רחוק שאנחנו יכולים עדיין כדאי.

ברוח דומה, בעלי המוסר אומרים לנו שיש הרבה רמות של תשובה, ולעולם אין להתייאש ולהרים ידיים. הסיבה לכך היא שכל רמה שנגיעה אליה היא הישג גדול בפני עצמו, שמביא אותנו למקום אחר לגמרי.

אולם ישנה גישה נוספת שראיתי בשם ספר העקרים. אנו אומרים בתהילים (קל:ד) "כַּי־עִמַדְּ הַסְּלִיחַה לְמַעַן תורא". השאלה ברורה. זה שה' יסלח לנו לא צריכה להביא אותנו ליראה אותו, אלא לאהוב אותו? ספר העקרים עונה שללא אפשרות של תשובה ברקע, היינו רואים את עצמנו כאבודים ואפילו היראת ה' ייפגע. אבל עכשיו, בעשרת ימי תשובה, ה' קרוב אלינו כי הוא רוצה לסלוח לנו וכפי שאומר הפסוק "בהיותו קרוב"). עם הידיעה שה' מצפה לסלוח לנו, זה מעודד אותנו לעשות תשובה, שתגרום לנו יראת ה'.

לפיכך, עשרת ימי תשובה, כולל יום כיפור, אמורה להיות התקופה המעודדת ביותר בשנה. ה' אומר, "אני לא מוותר עליכם!" בואו נעשה את שלנו ו"נשאר במשחק", כדי שנוכל להגיע לרמות גבוהות יותר של יראת ה'.
